



Seminario Bíblico William Carey is a growing Spanish-speaking seminary based in Córdoba, Argentina. Our mission is to provide quality, accessible theological education throughout Latin America and beyond in areas where it has traditionally been inaccessible. The current enrollment stands at 266, a 56% increase from 2016. Eighty-two students across eight countries study through our online program while the remaining meet in person at our study centers located in Argentina, Chile and Cuba.

At Seminario Carey we believe that rather than Latin America simply being a mission field, it is becoming a missionary sending region. Although it is in the midst of significant evangelical growth there is still much to accomplish. In Argentina for example, only 9% of the population identifies with any form of Protestant denomination. Across Latin America, there is a great shortage of trained pastors and leaders to shepherd the growing population of believers, with over 85% of pastors having received little to no theological education. While we understand that education is not a prerequisite for biblical leadership, we are convinced that it is a critical tool for leaders to navigate the issues that come with shepherding believers in today's society.

Seminario Carey offers distinct advantages to many of these leaders:

- Biblically rooted theological education not found in most of Latin America.
- Online accessibility for students including those who live in remote areas and full-time working pastors.
- An accredited Master of Arts in Theological Studies through an agreement with SBTS (The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary).
- Upcoming accreditation through AETAL (Associação Evangelica de Educeção Teológia na América Latina).

To continue meeting the demand among Spanish-speaking pastors for quality theological education, we must grow our library of theological texts. These critical texts will facilitate our accreditation and program growth. To continue our mission, Seminario Carey is seeking the following.

- 1. A 10,000 volume library at our main campus in Córdoba, Argentina.
- 2. A small library of academic-level texts at each of our remaining study centers (Tucumán, Argentina; Saldán, Argentina; Temuco, Chile; Valdivia, Chile; Velasco, Cuba).
